A Goeglein/Kernodle motion carried on a 3 to 0 roll call vote to approve CD Smith minus additives D1-3 for Contract A and Advance Construction contingent on Village of Sullivan, Sanitary District, and Rural Development approval.

Discussion and Possible Action on Designating a Commission Representative for Construction and Identifying Authorizations

A Goeglein/Kernodle motion carried on a 3 to 0 roll call vote to approve Heather Rupnow and Kent Hoffman as the Commission Representative for Construction and Identifying Authorizations up to \$5,000 per instance with a cap of \$25,000 in total.

All Sanitary District workers are interested in staying on with the Commission when the merger is complete. The Village workers also are interested in staying on with the Commission. Nate Tillis, the head of the Sanitary District, provided a handout detailing his staffing recommendations.
